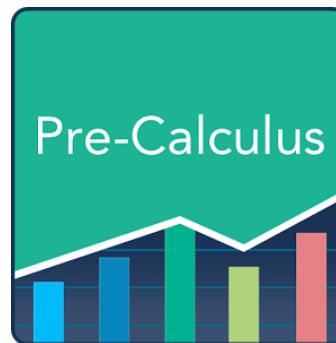

Prerequisites

Algebra II with Trigonometry, or Algebra II and Trigonometry

Course Description

## Attendance Policy

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Students are expected to attend class every day. These are guidelines regarding attendance.

1. Any student missing class because of a school-related activity (e.g. field trip, band, chorus, student government, etc.) will be held responsible for any material presented during the absence. It is the student's responsibility to see the teacher **prior** to an absence of this type to ensure the absence is anticipated and excused and to determine any work to be made up.
2. If a student is absent, then the student is expected to make up the work missed and find out what material was taught (see agenda). 3. Any work (including tests) missed because of **truancy or an unexcused absence** will result in receiving a zero for that work.

6. Credit for this course can be denied when the student **attends less than 90%** of the days in the semester.
